## SUMMER FUN FACTS!

In the winter of 1905, an 11-year-old boy named Frank Epperson invented the first **pop**sicle by accident. He accidentally left a mixture of powdered soda and water with a stirring stick on his porch. He awoke the next morning and found a frozen pop! He first named his frozen pop an "Epsicle", but when he got older his kids asked for "Pop's" sicle and the new name was born.

The average American eats around 5 1/2 gallons of **ice cream** a year! The late President Reagan declared July National Ice Cream Month. July is also the month that most ice cream is sold.

## SUMMER YUM!

### 5 MINUTE ICE CREAM!



#### WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- 1 tablespoon sugar
- 1/2 cup milk or half & half\*
- 1/4 teaspoon vanilla
- 6 tablespoons rock salt
- 1 pint size plastic food storage bag (Ziploc)
- 1 gallon size plastic food storage bag
- Ice cubes

#### DIRECTIONS:

1. Fill the large Ziploc bag half full of ice and add the rock salt. Seal the bag.
2. Put milk, vanilla and sugar into the small Ziploc bag & seal it.
3. Place the sealed small bag in-

side the large one and seal it again carefully.

4. Shake the sealed bags until the mixture is ice cream, which takes about 5 minutes.

5. Remove the small bag and wipe off the top. Carefully open & scoop ice cream into a bowl or cake cone and enjoy!

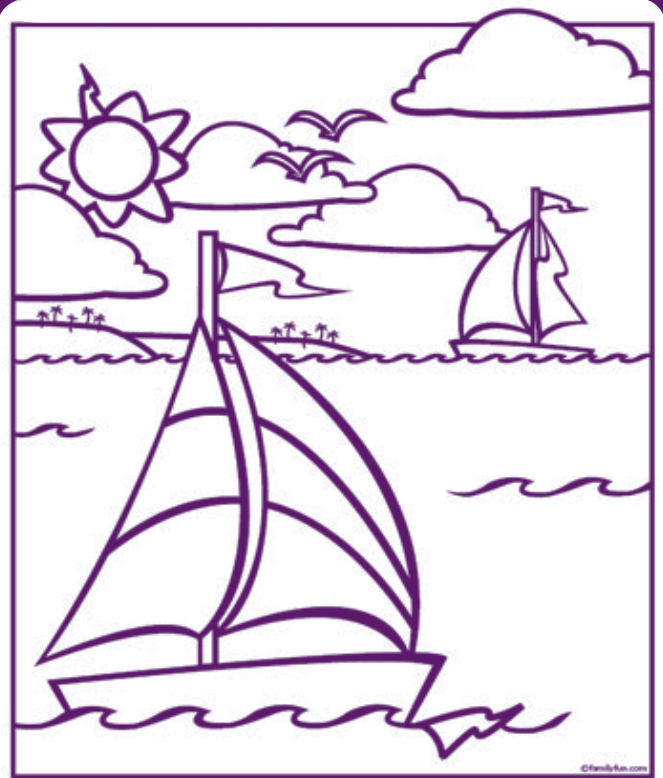
#### 6. OPTIONAL:
