RULES & ELIGIBILITY

- Be a graduating senior from Hawai'i Island public or private school system with intentions to further their studies at a vocational school, community college or university
- Properly or creatively answer the essay question with maximum of 1,000 words, typed using 12 pt. Times New Roman font and double spaced, include a cover page with the applicant's name and high school
- Provide their high school transcript as a form of school verification. There is no minimum GPA requirement for the scholarship program
- Provide a one-page resume with references. Resume should at least cover any work experiences, extra-curricular activities, volunteer work or awards
- Must fill out and sign scholarship application form
